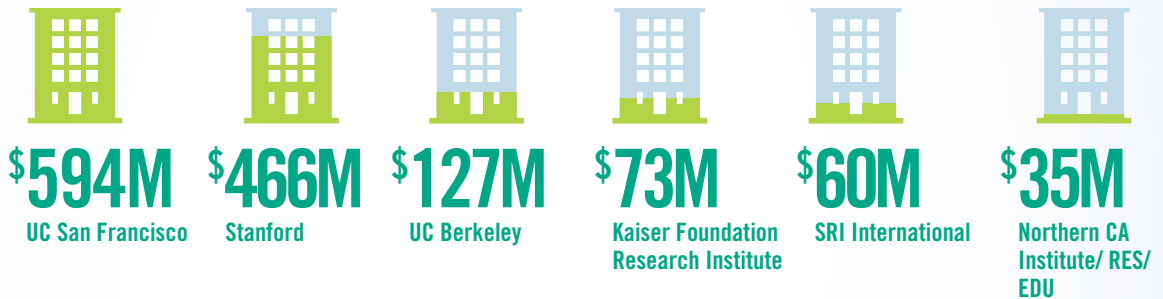
B A Y A R E A

The Bay Area's life science community rests on a foundation of scientific progress and training supported by the National Institutes of Health (NIH). It employs over **96,000 people** in five sectors: biopharmaceuticals, medical



devices and diagnostics, research and lab services, industrial biotechnology and biofuels, and life science wholesale. The industry in the Bay Area generates almost **\$113.8 billion** in economic activity.
