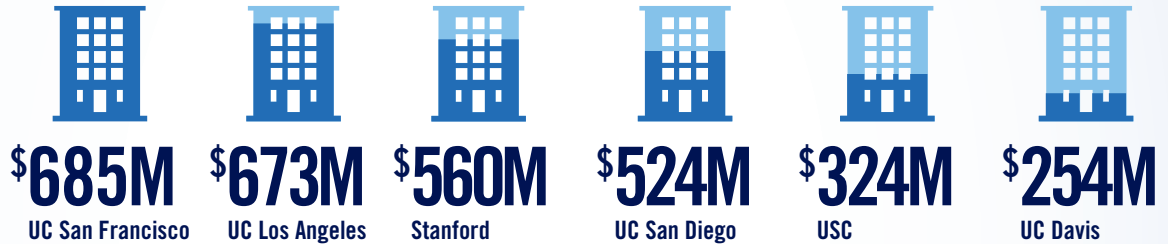
## C A L I F O R N I A
