California's life science community rests on a foundation of scientific progress and training supported by the National Institutes of Health (NIH). The life sciences industry in California employs almost **1.2 million Californians**,



436,000 directly, and 734,000 indirectly, with an average wage of over **\$95,000**. In total, it generates almost **\$376 billion** in economic output.
