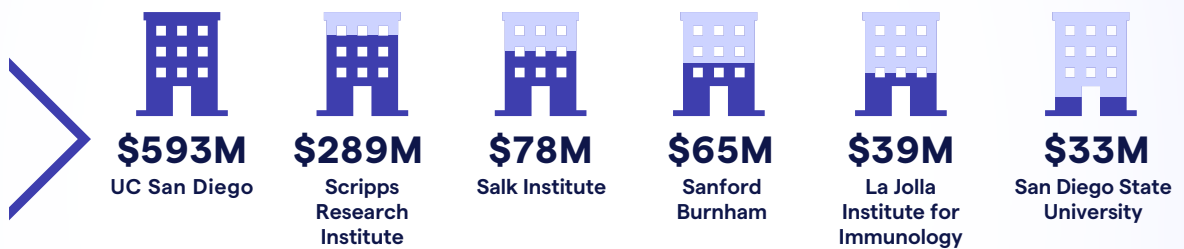

TOP 6 SAN DIEGO COUNTY PROJECT RECIPIENTS FOR FY 2022:



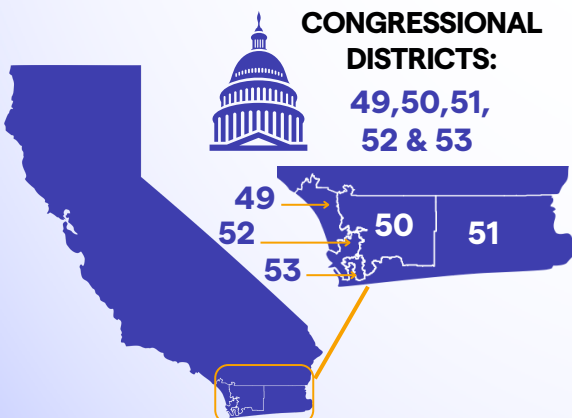
